Day 1 December 4th, 2018

Departure Promptly @ 7:00 am (Please arrive 15 minutes before departure time to load bus)

We will stop for lunch in LaGrange, Ga, then head to the Biblical History Center. We will step back in time as we sit in an authentic goat hair tent like the nomadic shepherds lived in, see tombs like those in which Abraham and Jesus were buried, and catacombs early Christians used for worship. We will learn about the worship practices of pagans, Jews, and Christians from 2500 BCE to 500 CE, and explore excavated houses of worship from Israel. See 250 ancient artifacts in real-life settings in the Biblical Life Artifacts Gallery. After a great afternoon of Biblical History we will head to our hotel to rest and get ready for dinner at one of Pine Mountain, GA's top rated restaurants. After a delicious dinner we will bundle up for a trip to see the lights at Callaway Gardens. Christmas at Callaway, featuring Fantasy In Lights, is one of *National Geographic's* Top 10 Light Displays in the world with eight million lights sparkling in the wooded landscape. We will grab some cocoa and sing along as we enjoy all the splendor of the season in our trolley ride through the Gardens.

Day 2 December 5th, 2018

We will have breakfast at the hotel, load the bus and head out for a tour of Hill and Dales Estate. This historic estate was the home of textile magnate Fuller E. Callaway, Sr. and his family. The property features the historic Ferrell Gardens, which are one of the best preserved 19th century gardens in America. The gardens were created by Sarah Ferrell between 1841 and 1903 and include extensive boxwood plantings, fountains, an herb garden and a green house. We will tour the house, gardens and several museum displays throughout the estate. We will have lunch in Warm Springs, GA then take a little time to see the town of Warm Springs, and hopefully find some Christmas gifts from the many local shops in the downtown area. Afterward we will get on the bus and relax while we let the driver do all the work and return us to Dothan.
